<b>Academic advising for study abroad:</b>	<p><b>These are the questions students should discuss with their advisor(s):</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• How does a semester/summer/academic year abroad fit into my degree completion plan?</li> <li>• How will the courses I select apply to my major/minor (usage)?</li> <li>• Can/should I consider taking my major/minor requirements before and after my study abroad?</li> <li>• If I study abroad, will it affect my graduation date? (does their course or program selection put them behind)</li> </ul>
<b>Application deadlines</b>	<p><b>Spring and calendar year programs:</b> September 15<sup>th</sup> (early action deadline June 15<sup>th</sup>)</p> <p><b>Summer, fall &amp; academic year programs:</b> February 15<sup>th</sup></p> <p><i>Note: study abroad scholarships are due at the same time</i></p>

<b>Transcripts</b>	<p>Depending on the program, transcripts are not automatically sent to UIUC and students have to put in a request with their host institution.</p> <p>Residential programs: transcripts will automatically be sent to LAS International Programs and the departments providing academic oversight will sign off on the credit recommendation forms.
